1 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 17 through 20, by striking out all  
2 of said lines and inserting

3 Section 1. Section 306(c)(22) and (f.1)(6)(ii) of the act of  
4 June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers'  
5 Compensation Act, are amended, subsection (c) is amended by  
6 adding a paragraph, subsection (f.1)(3)(vi) is amended by adding  
7 a subclause and subsection (f.1)(6) is amended by adding a  
8 subparagraph to read:

9 Amend Bill, page 2, by inserting between lines 2 and 3

10 (c) For all disability resulting from permanent injuries of  
11 the following classes, the compensation shall be exclusively as  
12 follows:

14 (22) For serious and permanent disfigurement of [the head,  
15 neck or face] the body, of such a character as to produce an  
16 unsightly appearance, and such as is not usually incident to the  
17 employment, sixty-six and two-thirds per centum of wages not to  
18 exceed [two hundred seventy-five weeks.] four hundred weeks.  
19 Disfigurement benefits paid to the injured worker shall be made  
20 separate and apart from total or partial disability. A claimant  
21 is not precluded from collecting both total or partial  
22 disability benefits and a disfigurement benefit simultaneously.

23 (22.1) For serious and permanent disfigurement of the body  
24 of first responders, which shall include firefighters, ambulance  
25 personnel and police, of such a character as to provide an  
26 unsightly appearance and such as is not usually incident to the  
27 employment, sixty-six and two-thirds per centum of wages not to  
28 exceed four hundred weeks. Disfigurement benefits paid to the  
29 injured worker shall be made separate and apart from total or  
30 partial disability. A claimant is not precluded for collecting  
31 both total or partial disability benefits and a disfigurement  
32 benefit simultaneously.
