1 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 17 through 20, by striking out all
2 of said lines and inserting

3 Section 1. Section 306(c)(22) and (f.1)(6)(ii) of the act of
4 June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers'
5 Compensation Act, are amended, paragraph (3)(vi) is amended by
6 adding a subclause and paragraph (6) is amended by adding a
7 subparagraph to read:

8 Amend Bill, page 2, by inserting between lines 2 and 3

9 (c) For all disability resulting from permanent injuries of
10 the following classes, the compensation shall be exclusively as
11 follows:

12 * * *

13 (22) For serious and permanent disfigurement of [the head,
14 neck or face] the body, of such a character as to produce an
15 unsightly appearance, and such as is not usually incident to the
16 employment, sixty-six and two-thirds per centum of wages not to
17 exceed [two hundred seventy-five weeks.] four hundred weeks.
18 Disfigurement benefits paid to the injured worker shall be made
19 separate and apart from total or partial disability. A claimant
20 is not precluded from collecting both total or partial
21 disability benefits and a disfigurement benefit simultaneously.
