11 (c) (1) The terms "injury" and "personal injury," as used
12 in this act, shall be construed to mean an injury to an employe,
13 regardless of his previous physical condition, except as
14 provided under subsection (f), arising in the course of his
15 employment and related thereto, and such disease or infection as
16 naturally results from the injury or is aggravated, reactivated
17 or accelerated by the injury; and wherever death is mentioned as
18 a cause for compensation under this act, it shall mean only
19 death resulting from such injury and its resultant effects, and
20 occurring within three hundred weeks after the injury. The term
21 "injury arising in the course of his employment," as used in
22 this article, shall not include an injury caused by an act of a
23 third person intended to injure the employe because of reasons
24 personal to him, and not directed against him as an employe or
25 because of his employment; nor shall it include injuries
26 sustained while the employe is operating a motor vehicle
27 provided by the employer if the employe is not otherwise in the
28 course of employment at the time of injury; but shall include
29 all other injuries sustained while the employe is actually
30 engaged in the furtherance of the business or affairs of the
31 employer, whether upon the employer's premises or elsewhere,
32 shall include all injuries sustained while the employe is
33 engaged in strike activity at or in the vicinity of the

1 employer's premises and shall include all injuries caused by the
2 condition of the premises or by the operation of the employer's
3 business or affairs thereon, sustained by the employe, who,
4 though not so engaged, is injured upon the premises occupied by
5 or under the control of the employer, or upon which the
6 employer's business or affairs are being carried on, the
7 employe's presence thereon being required by the nature of his
8 employment.
